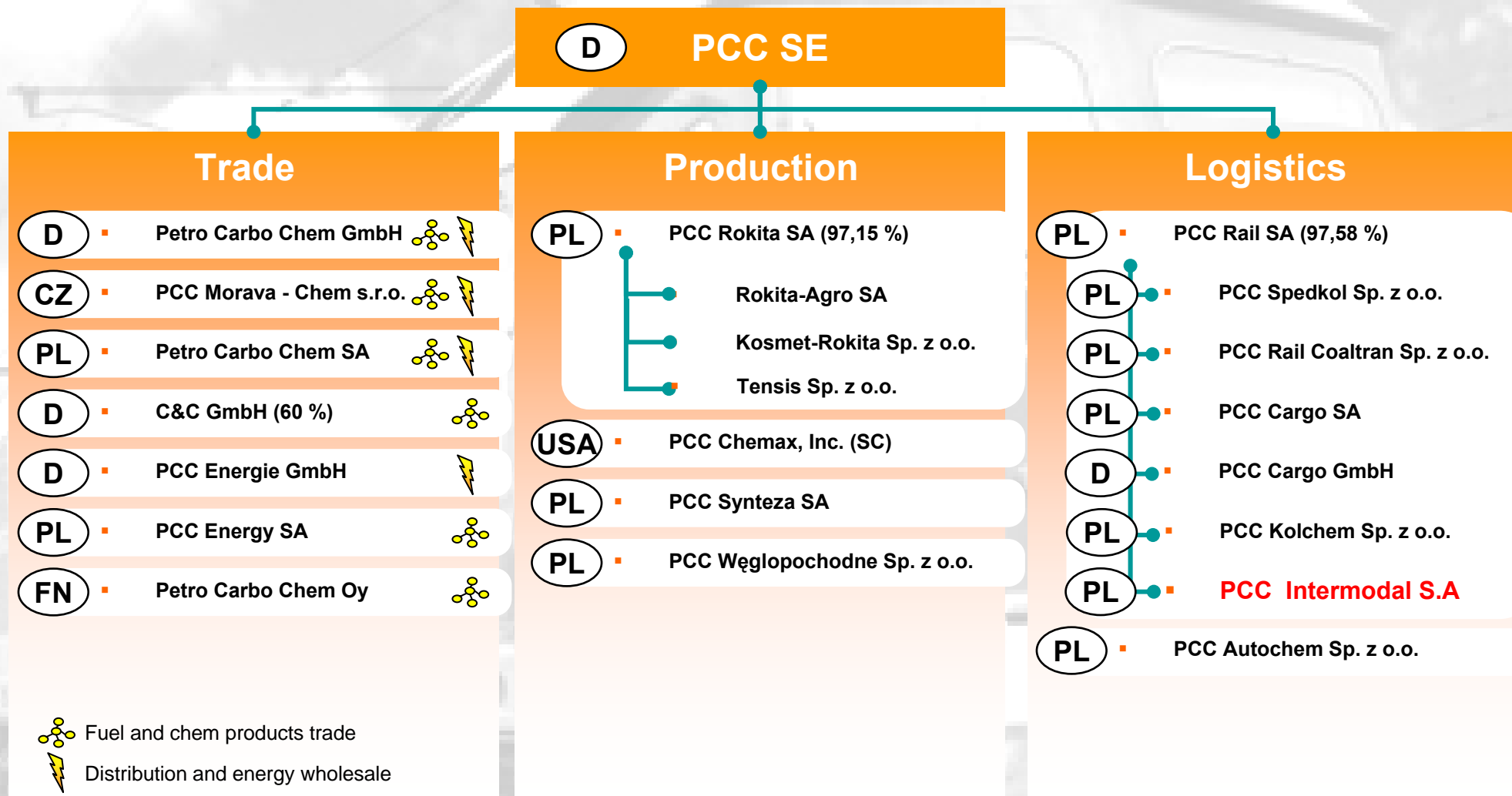

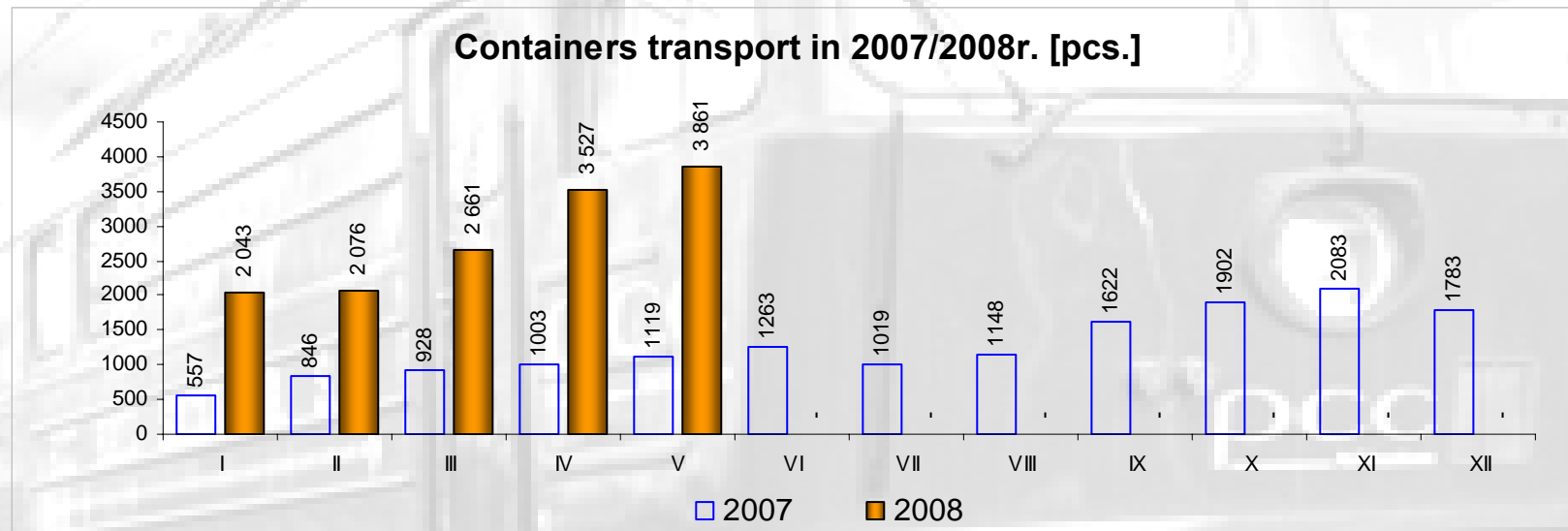

Main scope of the PCC group activities

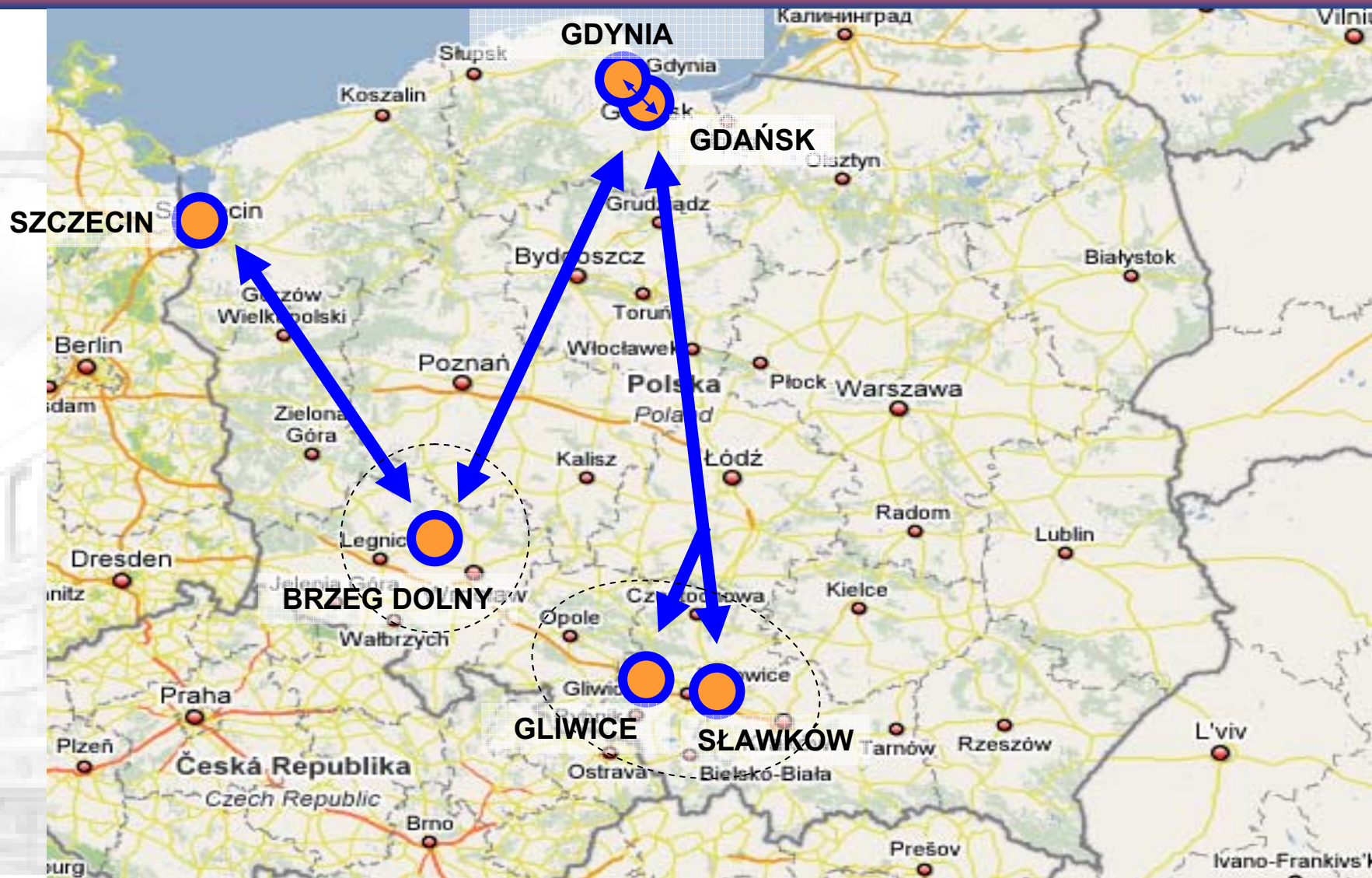


In 2007 PCC Intermodal carried over 15.000 containers (over 22.000TEUs) what is estimated to be around 20% of market share in rail transport of containers to/from polish marine terminals.



During I-V 2008 PCC Intermodal carried 14.158 containers what resulted in an **increase of 219%** comparing to I-V 2007.

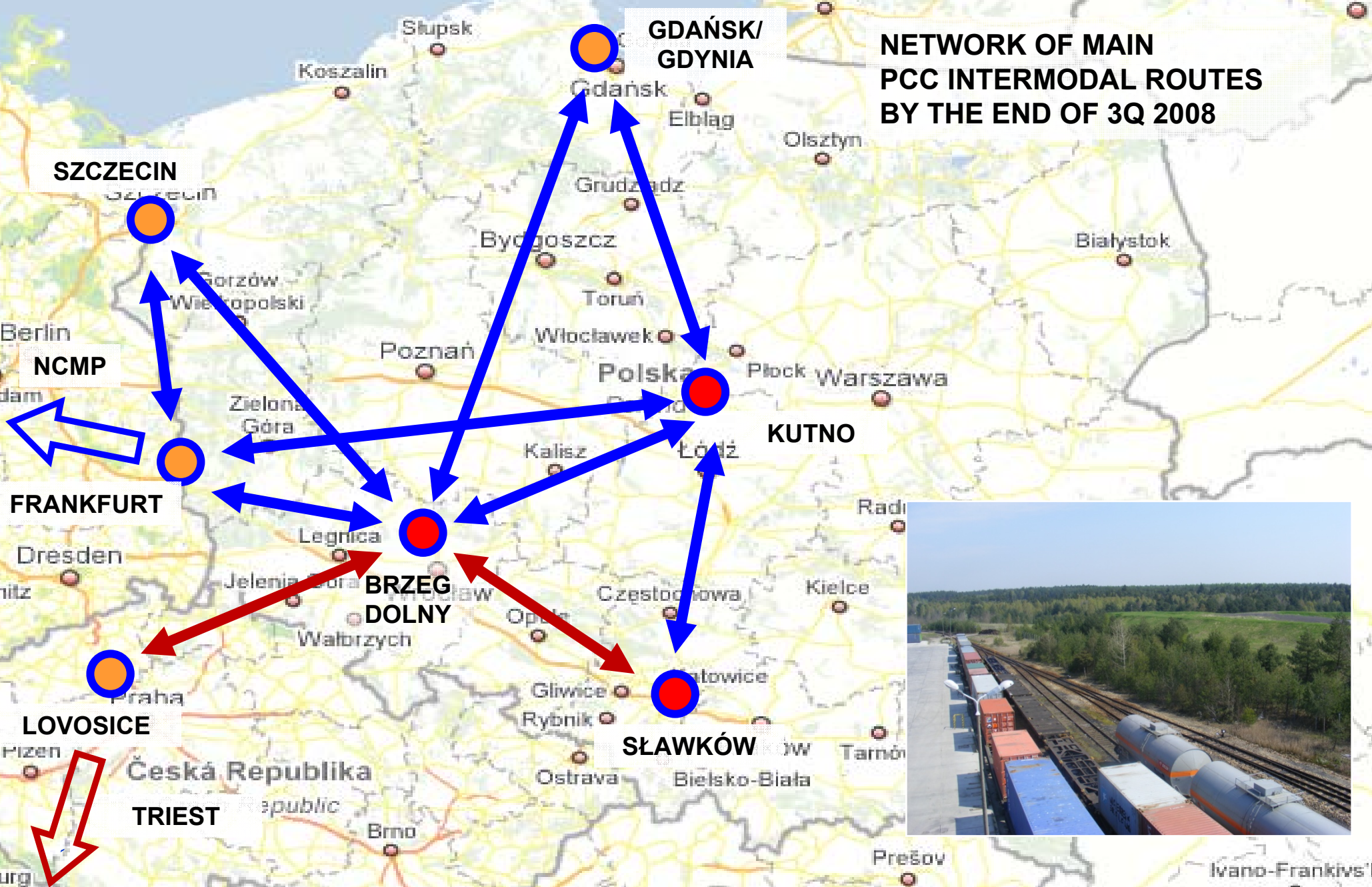
Routes offered from mid. June 2008

reduce number of long distance truckings in Poland by taking containers from roads to rail; offering at the same time first quality services to our customers

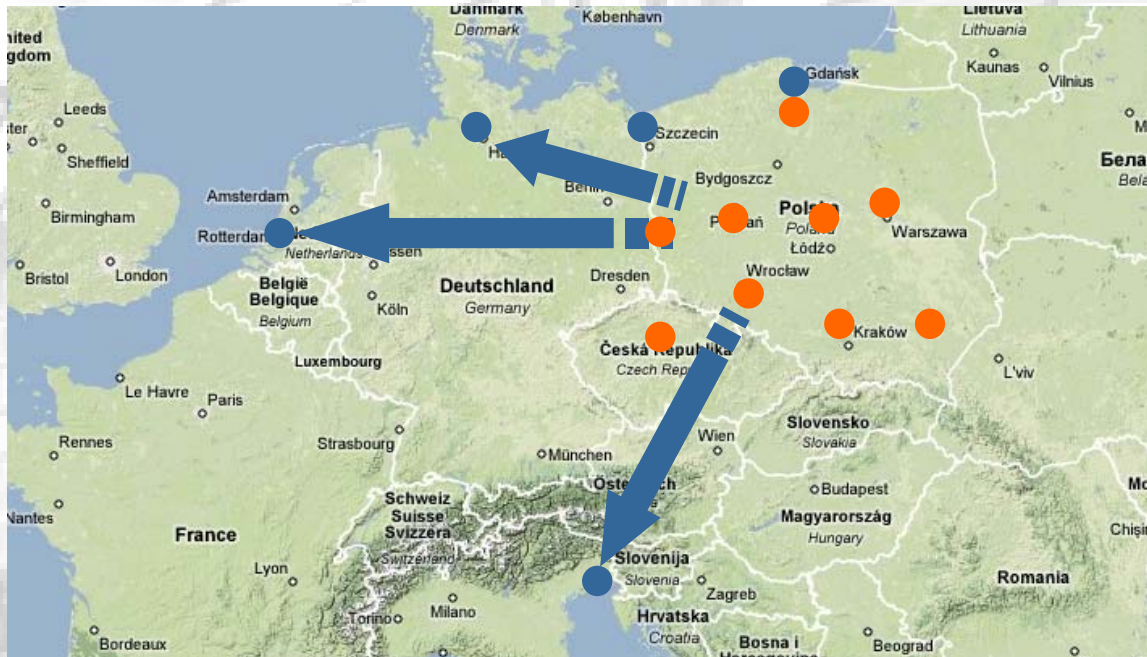


become one of the leading operators on Polish and european intermodal market
